Diplomas Need To Be Signed: All graduated seniors need to drop off their diploma at school for Ms. Warden and Mr. Goldie to sign. If they are not both available that day, leave your diploma on Mrs. Sinichko's desk (you'll see a box labeled "Summer Drop-Offs") and she will email you and your parents when it is signed and ready to be picked up.

Graduation DVDs: Stop by GW to pick up your graduation DVD anytime between 8:00 am – 3:00 pm.

Graduation Photos: The graduation photos will be posted on a site where you will be able to order whatever quantity or size you prefer. Watch for an email providing the link as soon as they are available.

College Transcripts: Final transcripts will be mailed to the college you chose by the end of June.
